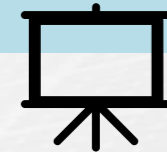

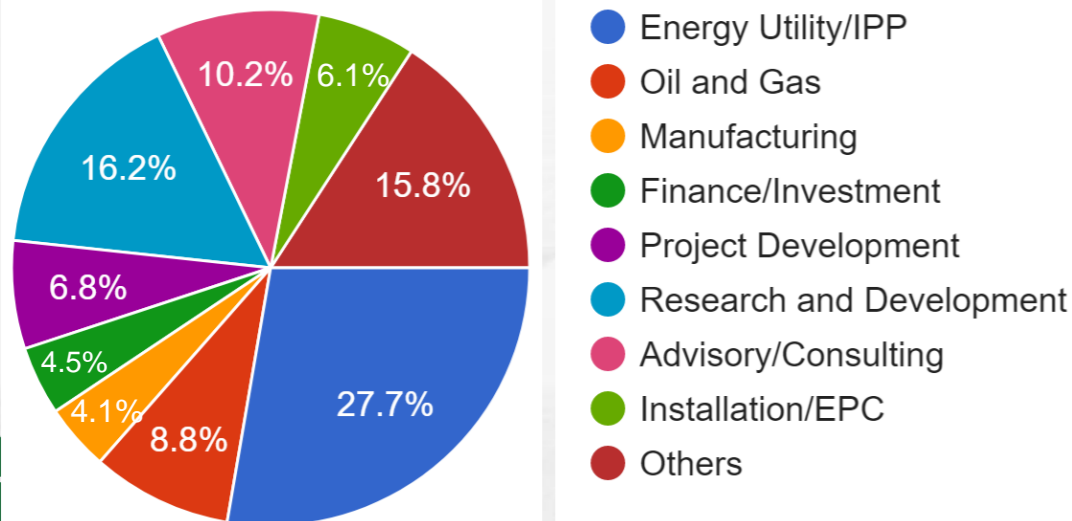

What is the NEF?

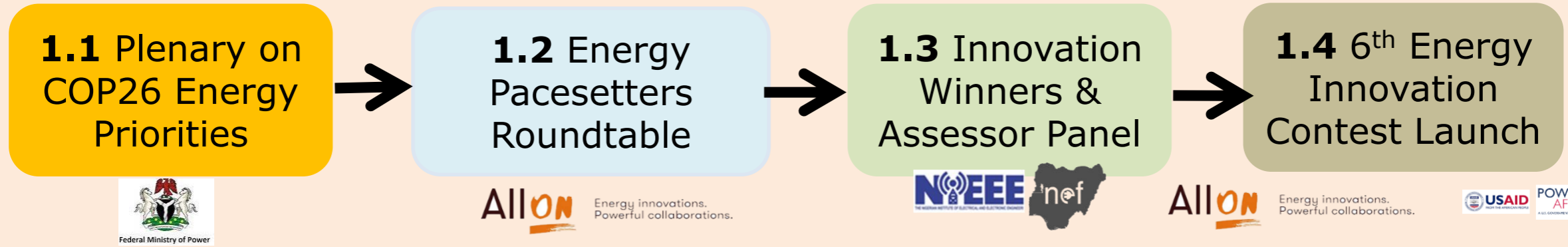
- NEF is a **capacity building, training & development** programme for policy makers, energy users, business leaders, industry experts, professional engineers, academics & research institutions.

NEF is organised by:

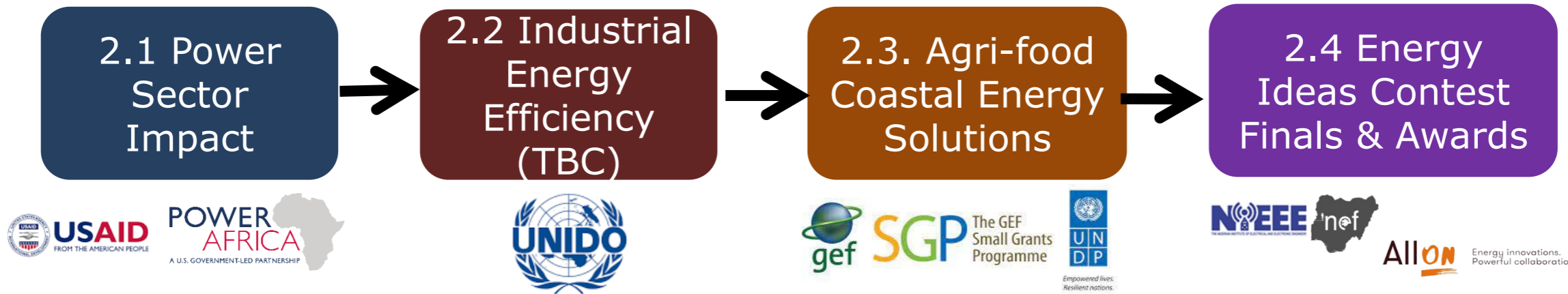
- A team of **young** energy professionals, researchers and academics in Nigeria & the UK.

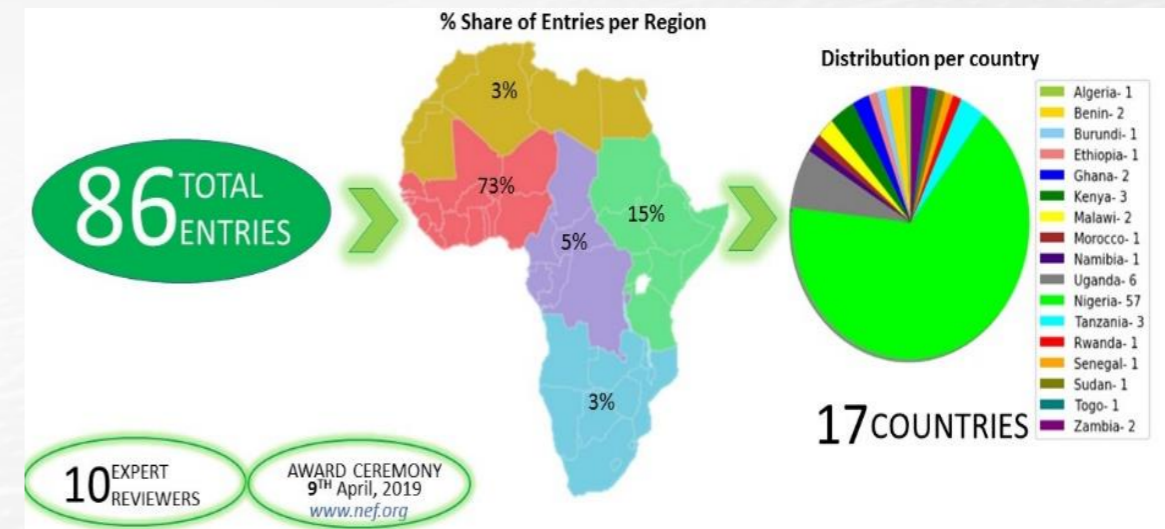
